Dear Friends:

We wish all of you a healthy and happy New Year and welcome to a New Decade with New Hope! Looking back on 2019, you may be thinking that you are grateful that you 'made it' through another year! Living with cancer as a patient and caregiver is often a story of 'small victories'. And, sometimes the best news is that your loved one is 'maintaining' or there has been 'no change'. Over the past 28 years of cancer doctor appointments with my husband, Jack, there was always anxiety, sometimes relief, but mostly gratitude!

We have seen amazing changes and accomplishments in cancer research and treatment since Jack's diagnosis in 1991. This week, the American Cancer Society came out with the latest statistics. The overall death rate has been falling about 1.5% a year since 1991. It fell 2.2% from 2016 to 2017. It is the largest drop ever seen in national cancer statistics going back to 1930 according to Rebecca Siegel, the author of the ACS Report https://www.foxbusiness.com/markets/americas-cancer-death-ratesees-biggest-ever-one-year-decline-group-says.

Since we started Arizona Myeloma Network® in 2004, we have seen tremendous advances in myeloma research and treatment options, as well as longer survival rates. We also have observed and experienced improved quality of life because of a more wholistic approach to treatment, including nutrition and life style changes, as well as support services. We believe that by educating cancer patients and families they can advocate better for themselves. Our Cancer Caregivers programs (for all cancers) grew out of this 'belief' and are now important components in many treatment centers. We are proud that Arizona Governor Doug Ducey recognized our work with Cancer Caregivers when he issued a Proclamation for the week of November 16-23, 2019 as Cancer Caregivers Awareness Week. Next year, we hope that it can become a national recognition week honoring all cancer caregivers for the important role they play in the health and life of the patient and the family.

I am excited to have been invited to write a book to share not only our own experience with cancer but also your 'story'. The book is titled: 'Living with Cancer, a CareGivers Journey'©. We will have the added wisdom and information of our guest authors, including many myeloma and cancer researchers, specialists, and other healthcare professionals.
